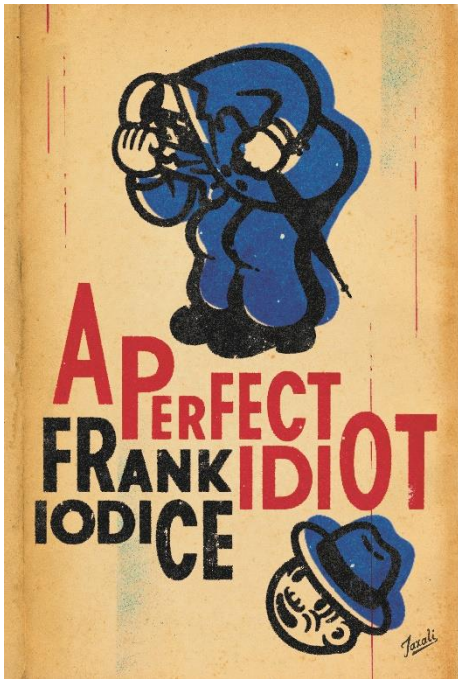


A Perfect Idiot
